POLITICAL SCIENCE BACHELOR

1st year, 1 semester

SCIENTIFIC COMPETENCES - workshops

2 ECTS

PERSONAL SKILLS: COMMUNICATION - workshops

Students will be introduced to selected tools of effective communication (paraphrasing, self-message, naming feelings, naming emotions, open/closed questions, feedback). Students will gain proficiency in the appropriate choice of communication style depending on the situation, and will develop skills in the appropriate choice of communication style depending on the situation, the ability to communicate effectively in the process of solving individual and group problems.

1 ECTS

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY - tutorials

Students will be introduced to the concepts of information technology, multimedia and media convergence. Students will gain the ability to use tools and applications needed for office work and will develop the ability to read and create multimedia messages.

ELECTIVE: *FUNDAMENTALS OF PHILOSOPHY / **HISTORY OF PHILOSOPHY – project

*FUNDAMENTALS OF PHILOSOPHY

Students will be introduced to the most important concepts and issues of philosophy. Students will gain knowledge of the history of European philosophy and enrich skills related to resolving moral dilemmas that arise in everyday life. They will be able to develop a dialogical attitude - skills of discussion and cooperation within a team.

**HISTORY OF PHILOSOPHY

Students will be introduced to philosophical issues as present in everyone's life. They will become equipped with the knowledge necessary to face philosophical problems independently. Students will form the ability to formulate and justify their own position, understand other people's views and critically respond to them.

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ELECTIVE: *SOCIOLOGY AND METHODS OF SOCIOLOGICAL RESEARCH /

- **GENERAL SOCIOLOGY tutorials
- *SOCIOLOGY AND METHODS OF SOCIOLOGICAL RESEARCH

The aim of the course is to gain knowledge about he basic assumptions of sociological research and the concepts of sociological research. The course will also review the basic methods of contemporary sociological research, as well as overview the research process.

** GENERAL SOCIOLOGY

Students after this course possess sociological knowledge at the theoretical and empirical level. They deepen knowledge in the social sciences; gain the ability to interpret social phenomena, especially those directly related to politics; form social attitudes affecting conscious and active participation in socio-political life.

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ELECTIVE: *MICRO&MACROECONOMICS / **FUNDAMENTALS OF ECONOMICS – project

*MICRO&MACROECONOMICS

The aim of the course is to gain the basic knowledge about the functioning of the modern economy at the level of an economic entity (microeconomics) and the economy as a whole (macroeconomics). The students will learn to have a broad and open view of the economic reality.

2 ECTS

**FUNDAMENTALS OF ECONOMICS

Students will learning the methodological basis and theory of economics; methods of analyzing economic processes and principles of functioning of markets; main economic categories and the laws and principles of development of the modern market economics; they will master the language and basic tools of economic analysis and understand the role of the state in the economy.

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INTRODUCTION TO POLITICAL SCIENCE RESEARCH - project

The aim of the course is to gain knowledge about the basic assumptions- cognitive, methodological and ethical- of political research, its concepts and types of information sources used in its research. The course will review the basic methods of contemporary political science, as well as overview the research process.

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2 ECTS

THE STATE AND LAW SCIENCE - project

The aim of the course is to provide an understanding of basic conceptual categories describing the state and law, to get acquainted with the basis of legal and state function terminology. The students will learn to master the elementary knowledge regarding forms and stages of the state and law formation process, as well as acquire the ability to use the sources of learning about the law independently, as well as understanding of the elements of Polish law.

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2nd year, 1st semester

FOREIGN POLICY OF THE REPUBLIC OF POLAND - lecture

This course aims to provide knowledge of the determinants, objectives and main directions of Polish/English foreign policy after 1989, as well as to discuss Polish/English relations with the most important foreign partners. The student knows the functions of foreign policy, indicates its determinants and the basic objectives and means by which they can be achieved; analyzes the main international agreements signed by Polish/English governments after 1989 and the current Security Strategy of the Republic of Poland; knows the new directions that appeared in Polish/English foreign policy after 1989 and analyzes the reasons for their appearance; names the main Polish/English political partners and identifies the most important problems in mutual relations.

CREATIVE ENTITY DEVELOPMENT - tutorials

Students will improve creative thinking and action skills. They will be able to use many different ways to solve the same problem, design and consciously make changes in their lives.

HISTORY OF POLITICAL THOUGHT - tutorials

The aim of the course is to provide knowledge showing the transformations of concepts and ideas concerning the state, law and politics in a historical cross-section, from antiquity to nineteenth century, demonstrating the relationship between the elements of continuity and change, as well as inspire interests that allow the analysis of political practices and political institutions in terms of fundamental questions about meaning of human action, fundamental goals and values. The students will learn to recognize, analyze and compare ideas and concepts that form the backbone of the main currents of the political tradition of the West.

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CONTEMPORARY POLITICAL SYSTEMS AND IDEAS - project

The aim of the course is to gain knowledge about the role of political organizations and institutions in the life of contemporary societies, the difference between the specificity of political systems and factors determining their character. The students will learn the possibility to describe political systems from different points of view, as well as flexibly choose various interpretations, descriptions of political systems and how to use them freely in solving problems.

CONTEMPORARY POLITICAL SYSTEMS AND IDEAS - lecture

DEMOCRACY, TRADITIONS AND PROSPECTS / LEGITIMIZATION OF POWER - project

The aim of the course is the gain knowledge of definitions and types of political power and political legitimacy, as well as present a methodological and axiological dilemma of legitimation. The students will familiarize the methods of implementing political power and its legitimation, as well as raise awareness of the problem of devaluation of the power in modern democracies.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLICY – lecture SPECIALIZATION: ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE

INTERNET AND THE LANGUAGE OF POLITICS - project SPECIALIZATION: E-POLITICS AND PR IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE

The aim of the course is to gain knowledge about the role of new media in a democratic society, at various levels of social organization- at the central, regional, local and finally environmental levels. The course will also cover the topic of creating a basis for gaining further theoretical and practical knowledge in the field of using media in planning and conducting an election campaign as well as creating and maintaining the image of people performing public functions. The course will discuss the issues of political advertising and mass communication, the essence of political advertising, organization of campaigns and e-advertising campaigns, as well as discussing the methods and channels of advertising influence via the Internet. The students will learn the techniques of exerting influence of in the Internet environment, strengthening a critical attitude towards manipulation on the Internet.

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2 ECTS

THEORY OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS – tutorials SPECIALIZATION: INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND BUSINESS ON THE EUROPEAN MARKET

The student knows and understands the most important theoretical problems concerning the development of international relations in the global and Eurasian dimensions. They are able to analyze, to an elementary extent, the logic of the functioning of international relations and foreign policy of states on the basis of the learned theoretical schemes and principles established by conventions and international custom. Student is also able to analyze the factors influencing the formation of international relations.

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2 ECTS

3 year, 5th semester

SOCIAL SKILLS: AWARENESS OF VALUES - workshops

This course will familiarize students with the concepts of axiology and prepare them to analyze their own hierarchy of values as well as show the relationship between the choices made and the needs and values.

POLITICAL MARKETING - project

The aim of the course is to introduce and familiarize students with issues related to the techniques and methods of political marketing as well as political and public communication. The course will present practice and evaluate political and election campaign from the perspective of its main participants: party activists, political consultants, journalists and citizens. The students will acquire basic knowledge and skills in analyzing election campaigns and analyzing tools used in preparation of election campaigns and auxiliary strategies.

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ELECTIVE: *INFORMATION SOCIETY/ **CIVIL SOCIETY - tutorials

*INFORMATION SOCIETY

The aim of the course is to analyze the trends determining the formation of modern society, and present characteristics of changes and social processes which traditionally understood Western society has undergone, as well as provide an overview of various alternative society concepts and their projects for the future.

**CIVIL SOCIETY

The goal of this course is for a student to gain knowledge of what civil society is, what are its definitions operating in the social sciences, and the ability to indicate the various stages of its genesis and development; to be able to analyze and interpret contemporary phenomena from the socio-political sphere in the perspective of relating them to the private-public dichotomy; to understand of the dynamics of

contemporary socio-political processes; possess the ability to make constructive criticism of contemporary phenomena and socio-political processes based on knowledge; be familiarized with the literature of the subject and the ability to refer to it and use it in the analysis of surrounding phenomena; be prepared for conscious and active participation in contemporary socio-political reality and understanding the importance of one's choices and actions taken.

SELF-GOVERNMENT AND LOCAL POLITICS - project

The aim of the course is to gain knowledge about the links between the economic and social policy. Especially in context of dilemmas related to rapid economic development on the one hand and the implementation of the idea of social justice on the other, acquainting with social and economic problems and their place in political programs, as well as understanding the impact of social and economic problems on social and political life, and illustrating the economic effects of regulation and state intervention in the economy.

3 ECTS

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THE INTERNATIONAL TRADING SYSTEM OF THE WTO - tutorials SPECIALIZATION: INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND BUSINESS ON THE EUROPEAN MARKET

The student after studying this subject knows and understands the key rules of the international trade system created by the World Trade Organization. They are able to analyze to an elementary extent the key changes occurring in contemporary international trade relations.

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"EMERGING MARKETS" IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS – project SPECIALIZATION: INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND BUSINESS ON THE EUROPEAN MARKET

The student after studying this course knows and understands the most important theoretical problems concerning the so-called emerging plasters. They are able to analyze to an elementary extent the logic of the functioning of emerging markets in international relations, and to analyze the factors affecting the development of emerging markets.

PARTICIPATORY MANAGEMENT – project SPECIALIZATION: ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE

SHAPING PUBLIC OPINION – project SPECIALIZATION: E-POLITICS AND PR IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE

The aim of the course is to introduce the basic theoretical categories relating to public opinion, and present the practical dimension of the phenomenon of public opinion (opinion polls, shaping public opinion) as well as Creating the possibility of a critical view of the public opinion. The course will familiarize students with the issues of public opinion.

SCIENTIFIC COMPETENCES - workshops

2 ECTS

COMPETENCY MANAGEMENT METHODOLOGY - tutorials

Students become familiarized with the concept of social competence. They will know about the model of competencies and their ladder of development and the knowledge of the realized competence. Also, they will know possess the knowledge of competence management methodologies.

METHODOLOGY OF POLITICAL SCIENCE RESEARCH - project

The classes are designed to equip students with knowledge of the most widely understood concepts of research and related views on methods, defining the perspective of scientific cognition of politics, as well as acquiring knowledge of conducting political science research, using models and research methods, forming and developing their own research workshop. Their goal is to show the distinctiveness of the many currents of research shaping the tradition of political science research, to highlight the contentiousness of separate concepts of cognition and separate concepts of knowledge emerging in the field of political science.

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METHODOLOGY OF POLITICAL SCIENCE RESEARCH - lecture

CONSTITUTIONAL LAW - lecture

3 ECTS

The purpose of the subject is to learn about the genesis and process of formation of state law, subsequently transformed into a coherent system of laws and legal acts,

regulating the operation of the state and its authorities. This is served by learning about the process of forming divisions of power and assigning to each of them the appropriate bodies and the proper scope of competence. As a result, the educational process will also enable you to learn about the principles of modern constitutionalism.

POLITICAL SOCIOLOGY - tutorials

The goal of this course is the following:

- To acquire knowledge of the doctrinal-dogmatic principles and liturgical and organizational forms of the world's largest universal religions, religious and denominational associations, as well as contemporary new religious movements
- To familiarize students with the problems of the interrelationship between religion and politics and their mutual interpenetration
- To present the problems of mutual relations between politics and religion in modern times
- To indicate the main determinants of changes as well as their consequences for both elements of the system
- To develop an attitude of tolerance and openness to religious and worldview otherness, to raise the level of understanding and acceptance of religious freedom and the ability to explain and resolve religious-political or religious-social conflicts.

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ELECTIVE: *HISTORY OF POLITICAL DOCTRINES / **POLITICAL AND LEGAL DOCTRINES - lecture

*HISTORY OF POLITICAL DOCTRINES

Students will learn about political doctrines in the process of formation of modern Europe and the world, and the evolutionary nature of civilizational changes. They acquire the ability to evaluate historical events and their interrelation. After this course students have a structured knowledge of political doctrines; knowledge of man and their role in society, the forms of his activity in public life; knowledge of the

processes of change of political structures and institutions, their elements, the causes, course, scale and consequences of these changes.

**POLITICAL AND LEGAL DOCTRINES

The purpose of the course is to provide students with knowledge of ideological considerations of the nature of the state and law from ancient times to modern times in order to deepen their ability to think critically and evaluate legal phenomena. They know and understand the main currents of legal and political-social thought and, on this basis, has an expanded knowledge of the terminology functioning within philosophy, sociology and legal ethics; they know the various concepts and currents of the genesis and definition of the state and law, including the ability to identify the creators of individual ideas and their main representatives in historical development. Students know and understand the political-legal doctrines dominant in contemporary political discourse.

HISTORY OF POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS - tutorials

The purpose of the course is to learn about the origins and contemporary diversity of political institutions, occurring in a variety of forms and systemic formations, as well as the relationship between individual institutions and the rationale and effects of political ideas on them, taking into account the specific cultural, social and geographical conditions. After this course student has a structured knowledge of the most important historical events in the formation of political institutions. They have knowledge of various types of political institutions and relations between them in local, regional, state and international dimensions. They also know of the processes of change of political structures and institutions, their elements, the causes, course, scale and consequences of these changes.

HISTORY OF POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS - lecture

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POLITICAL THEORY - tutorials

The goal of this course is the following:

- To familiarize students with theoretical concepts in political theory and the theoretical output of modern political science;
- To demonstrate different types of political science analysis, especially systemic, behavioral and decision-making analysis for independent analysis of political phenomena and processes;
- To make independent interdisciplinary analyses of the political situation and its critical evaluation, as well as to assess the dynamics of changes in political theories; to analyze theories in a socio-historical context; to show the usefulness of theoretical approaches in the analysis of social processes.

PHILOSOPHY AND ETHICS OF POLITICS - tutorials

This course will equip students with the knowledge to ask questions about the nature of political order and its various interpretations. They will be able to point out the fundamental role of dilemmas, disputes and controversies in the sphere of interpretations that make it possible to understand and explain politics.

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2nd year, 1st semester

POLISH ARMED FORCES IN THE INTERNATIONAL SECURITY SYSTEM - tutorials

2 ECTS

The purpose of the course is to familiarize students with the concepts of security in international relations. Students get equipped with knowledge of the Polish armed

forces, to acquire the ability to analyze the operation of the Polish armed forces, to show the relationship between the strategic goal of the Polish state and the conditions necessary for the realization of a specific strategy using the armed forces. They know present issues concerning the modernization and professionalization of the Polish army.

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2 ECTS

INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS - project

The aim of the course is for students to master the knowledge of the issues of individual rights and freedoms. To explain the concept of human rights, the scope of their subject regulation, protection in national and international law, as well as the premises and scope of permissible restrictions, where the Court of Human Rights, the Court of Justice of the EU, the Constitutional Court and other judicial authorities are of key importance.

INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS - lecture

ELECTIVE: *HISTORY OF DIPLOMACY/ ** DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR LAW-tutorials

*HISTORY OF DIPLOMACY

Students after this course become familiar with the concepts of the history of diplomacy. They acquire the ability to correctly use terminology related to diplomacy and they develop understanding the essence and specifics of diplomacy.

** DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR LAW

After this course students obtain knowledge of the institutions of diplomatic and consular law. They know the concept and essence of diplomacy and consulate and diplomatic and consular law.

They understand the problems of state representation in international relations, especially in diplomatic and consular relations and they can characterize the law of legation and its subjects.

*CONTEMPORARY INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS

The goal of this course is the following:

- To familiarize students with the extensive issues of contemporary problems occurring in international relations.
- To make students understand the essence and specificity of contemporary problems of international politics.
- To develop in students analytical thinking, logical reasoning skills, and evaluation of the processes taking place in the modern world.

- To understand the causes and consequences of contemporary world problems.

2 ECTS

**CONTEMPORARY ARMED CONFLICTS

The goal is to familiarize students with the terminology of armed conflicts. Students will learn about the causes of explosions, the specifics of their course and methods of resolving armed conflicts. The student knows and correctly uses terminology in the study of armed conflicts and their resolution. They know and can properly apply the most important theoretical concepts on the causes of the outbreak of armed conflicts, the specifics of their course and methods of their resolution.

TRANSLATLANTIC RELATIONS - lecture

The aim of the course is to familiarize students with transatlantic relations, to show their genesis and influence on social, political and economic changes in mutual relations. Against the background of transatlantic relations, to show the role and importance of Poland in the emerging transatlantic relations. Students know the terminology of transatlantic relations in Polish and foreign language; understand the methods of analyzing popular science and scientific text in the field of transatlantic relations; justifies and criticizes political concepts on the basis of available empirical evidence and acquired knowledge.

ELECTIVE: *EUROPEAN LAW/LAW OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS -** tutorials

This course has the following goals:

- To familiarize with legal concepts and problems related to the functioning of the EU.
- To introduce the sources of EU law and the principles of its establishment,
- To acquire the ability to correctly use legal terminology related to European and EU law
- To understand the essence and specificity of community law
- To present the principles of application of community law

CRISIS MANAGEMENT - project SPECIALIZATION: SECURITY AND CRISIS MANAGEMENT

After completing the course, the student should be able to orient himself in the most important elements shaping the state security strategy, move freely among the concepts, possess the ability to analyze selected security strategies, be able to indicate the direction of influence and strategic goal, the conditions necessary for the realization of the strategy, recognize the conceptual and implementation elements in the process of creating the state security strategy.

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INTERNATIONAL LAW IN THE CONDUCT OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS - project

SPECIALIZATION: INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND BUSINESS ON THE EUROPEAN MARKET

The goal of this course is the following:

- The class is designed to provide the necessary body of general knowledge about the role of international law in business.
- To provide students with knowledge on determining the law applicable to international relations from the scope of EU law, Regulation (EC) No. 864/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of July 11, 2007 on the law applicable to non-contractual obligations (Rome II) and Regulation (EC) No. 593/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 17, 2008 on the law applicable to contractual obligations (Rome I).
- Students will learn about the problems that businesses undertaking and operating internationally must solve from a legal perspective.

2 ECTS

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THEORIES OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS AND TRADE - project SPECIALIZATION: INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND BUSINESS ON THE EUROPEAN MARKET

The class is designed to provide the necessary general knowledge of the theory of international business and trade. Students will learn the concepts of international business and trade and the mechanism of the global market. Students will learn about the problems that have to be solved by companies undertaking and conducting international business.

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
